BRITISH FLYBALL ASSOCIATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The event organiser(s) reserve the right to refuse entries and admission to the event of any persons not in good standing, within the BFA.
2. No persons shall carry out punitive or harsh handling of a dog at the event.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed near the show area.
4. Mating of dogs at the show is not allowed.
5. A dog must be withdrawn from the competition if it is:
 - Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease
 - A danger to the safety of any person or animal
 - Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues to compete
6. It is the team captain's responsibility to ensure the team is available for their class and running order.
7. The organiser(s) reserve the right to make any alterations they deem necessary in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
8. All dogs enter the event at their own risk and whilst every care will be taken, the event organiser(s) cannot accept any responsibility for damage, or loss however caused to dogs, persons or property whilst at the event.
9. **All owners/handlers must clear up after their dogs. Anyone failing to do so will be asked to leave the venue. This is an extremely beautiful setting for a Flyball Competition, Please make sure you leave the venue as clean and tidy as when you arrive.**
10. **Team Captains/ Managers are responsible for ensuring that all members of their teams and accompanying party are informed of the rules and regulations pertaining to this tournament. There will be some restrictions to where dogs can be walked, please do not take any dogs near or around Loseley House. Signs will be put up asking to keep dogs away from certain areas, please abide by this otherwise you will be asked to leave the venue.**
11. Current BFA rules and policies will apply throughout the sanctioned tournament.

This tournament will be run as a round robin competition with teams put into divisions of six wherever possible. ALL divisions will be run in consecutive order starting with the slower divisions on Saturday, finishing with the highest on Monday. Each division will be split into two halves, running one half in the morning and finishing the second half in the afternoon.

On Saturday night, held in a separate marquee there will be a Barn Dance and on Sunday night another evening of entertainment with Gary Dean.
